**TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:**

- Current enrollment in at least 6 units at Mesa College
- Have successfully completed a minimum of 12 units at Mesa College
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for Mesa College courses completed
- Have declared an academic goal of transfer to a four year institution
- Have an interest in pursuing a career in the service field

**APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 26, 2010**

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received By 12:00 February 26, 2010. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

**SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA**

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from Mesa College faculty, classified staff, student government, administration and Kappa Beta Nu Scholarship Committee.

**APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:**

Biographical Questionnaire	10 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher	20 points maximum
Internships/Community Service	20 points maximum
Essay	30 points maximum
Recommendation letters (1)	20 points maximum

**RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on May 7, 2010 at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

## **APPLICATION CHECKLIST**

*Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:*

1. A fully completed application-biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit one current letter of recommendation on official letterhead:
  - One (1) from a Mesa College faculty member (counselors are faculty members) specific to this scholarship and discussing your academic achievement and/or progress in your planned educational program.  
or
  - One (1) from a person (non-faculty) who can provide information regarding your internship(s) work-experience and/or community service activities.
3. Submit a well-written original essay about your background, your educational and career goals, and your interest in the area of geriatrics in the field of physical therapy. Your essay should not exceed 500 words.
4. Provide information regarding your specific financial need (parents if under 18).
