## SBFS25-002 - Positive Message Campaign Bill

**WHEREAS** Mesa College is committed to fostering community, empowerment, participation, and accountability.

WHEREAS In order to promote student wellbeing, mental health awareness, and positive campus culture, Mesa College Associated Student Government shall station around campus to engage with the student body during the Reflect, Restore, and Unite Week; and

WHEREAS Students shall be provided with opportunities to participate in a campus engagement activity by visiting a designated table in the quad, where they may create personalized affirmation cards and receive an affirmation card to take with them; and

WHEREAS The Associated Student Government (ASG) of San Diego Mesa College shall actively engage the student body by distributing pre-written affirmation cards throughout campus to promote encouragement and positivity; and

WHEREAS The Associated Student Government (ASG) of San Diego Mesa College shall design, prepare, and install signage featuring uplifting and supportive messages in high-traffic areas of campus (including the tennis courts, quad, and other prominent locations) to ensure visibility and impact.

**RESOLVED** The Associated Student Government (ASG) hereby authorizes the reimbursement of Victoria Miller in the amount of \$98.89 for expenses related to the Positive Message Campaign, not to exceed \$100, upon submission of valid receipts and documentation.
